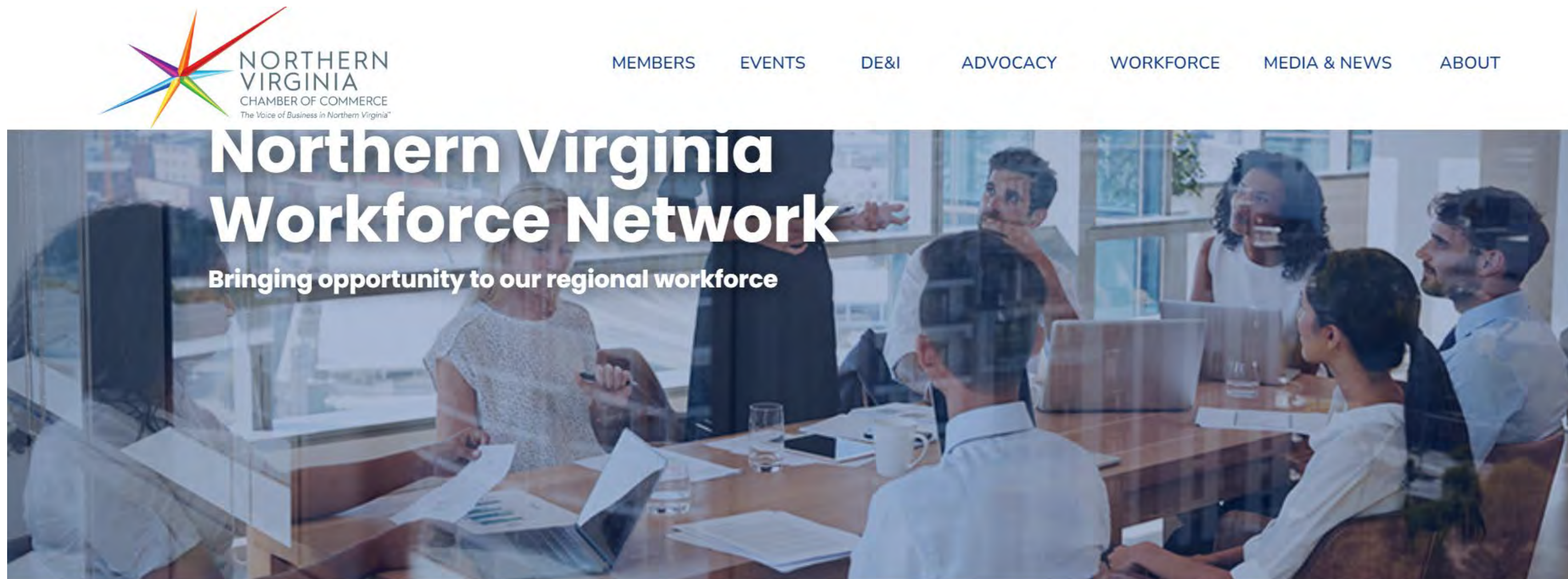

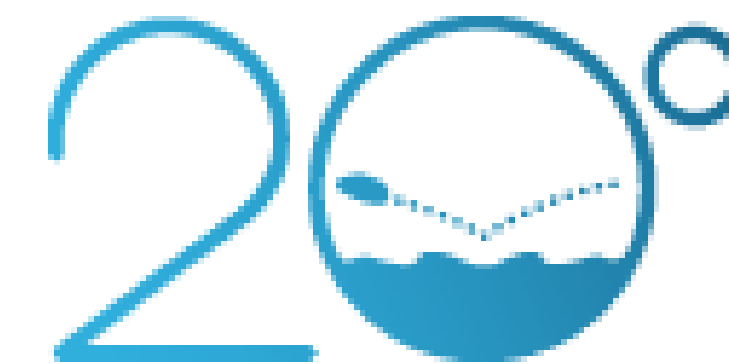

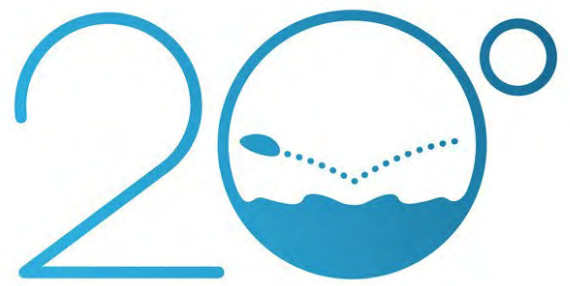

- Over 12,000 people are employed in Northern Virginia's Child Day Care Services industry.
- Average Wages per Worker in Northern Virginia is \$32,700.

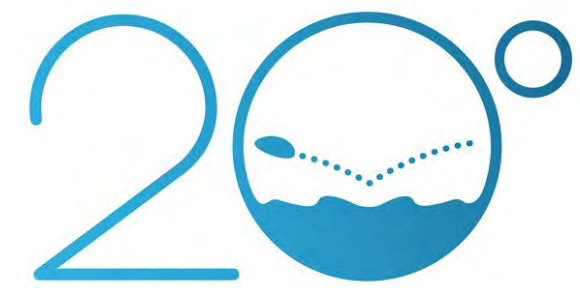


Market Research and Analysis



- In 2021, there were 8,100 slots offered for approximately 14,000 children under 5 in Arlington.
- Few providers offer off-hours care.
- In November 2021, the County Board approved \$5 million in capital funding for more child care slots.
- In September 2022, 115,290 people in the District of Columbia Metro Area cited childcare as a reason why they left the workforce.
