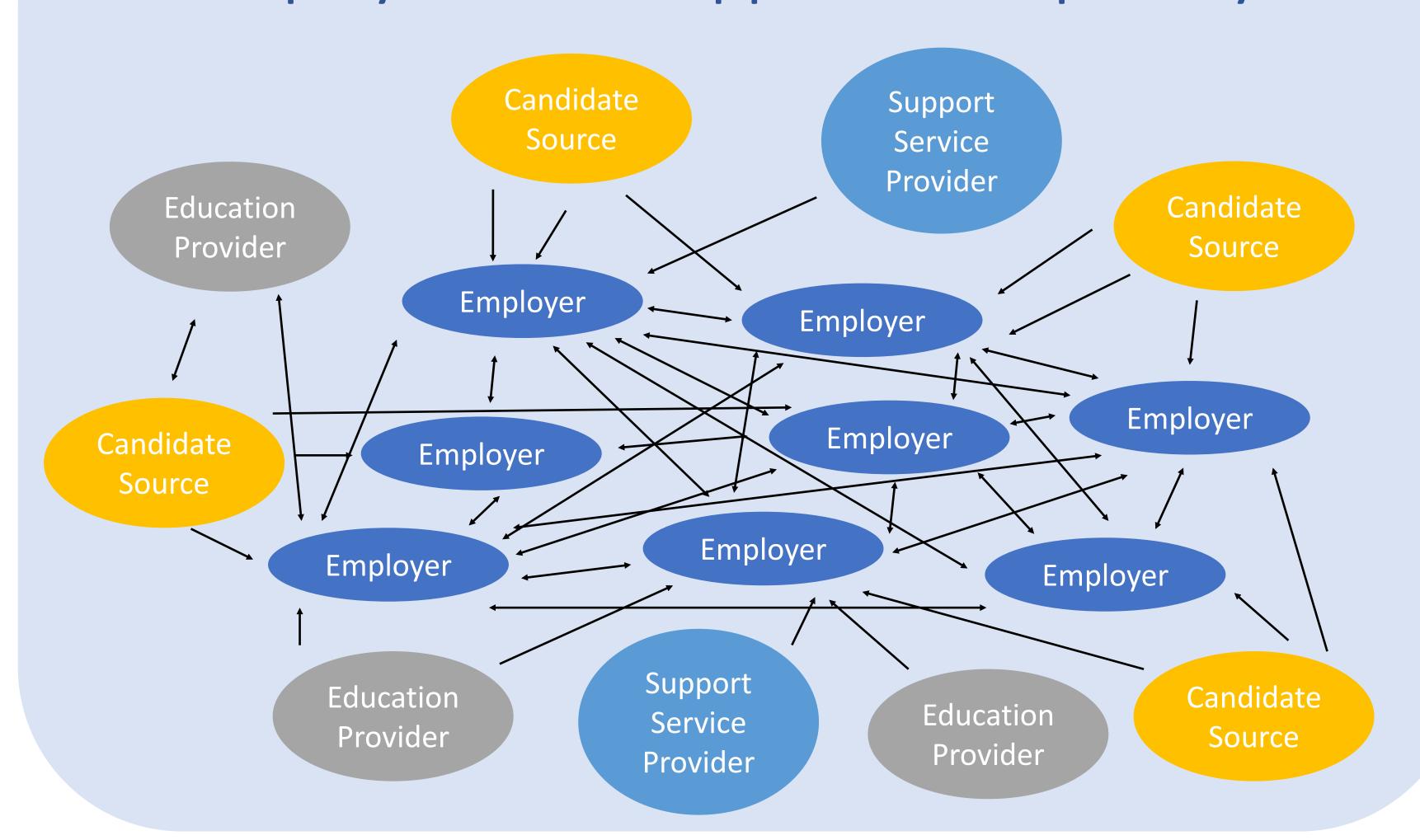
- Help employers in the region explore and develop an apprentice-based model of recruitment and training.

Hamdi made proactive efforts to hire refugees since launching Chobani. Refugees now account for 20–30% of the company's workforce.

Hamdi is a Kurdish-Turkish businessman & entrepreneur who immigrated to the United States. He has been named one of TIME's 100 Most Influential People in the World for his innovative approach to business and work on the refugee crisis.

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## What is a refugee?

#### Refugee

A **refugee** is an individual who has been forced to flee their country because of a well-founded fear of persecution or violence.

#### Asylum Seeker


An asylum seeker is an individual who has left their country of origin and has formally applied for asylum in another country but is waiting for a determination.


#### **Economic Migrant**

An **economic migrant** is someone who deliberately chooses to move to improve their life elsewhere.

The United States has been a global leader in refugee resettlement under both Democratic and Republican administrations

The U.S. is currently hosting

340,000 refugees

The Biden Administration plans to resettle an additional

200,000+ refugees

over the next 4 years

# The United States will also welcome ~100,000 Afghan allies

The U.S. will resettle at-risk Afghans, including those who worked alongside the American military as interpreters and translators and who face retaliation by the Taliban

There is strong bi-partisan support for resettling Afghans in the U.S.

The Washington DC/Northern Virginia area is one of the metro areas hosting the largest number of Afghans



## In September 2021 we launched the Tent Coalition for Afghan Refugees



To date, more than 70 major companies across the country and across industries have stepped up to support Afghan refugees primarily by hiring and training them









































#### **Our services for Coalition members**

- Guidance: Tailored guidance to help companies design effective refugee hiring and training programs
- 2. Best Practices: Monthly working group calls and training webinars to share best practices on integrating Afghan talent
- 3. Research: Commission cutting-edge research to help inform business decisions to work with Afghans
- 4. Local Partners: Connect companies to local partners, including all nine national resettlement agencies & their affiliates, to support company projects
- 5. Communications: Amplify members' refugee efforts on social media and in press


